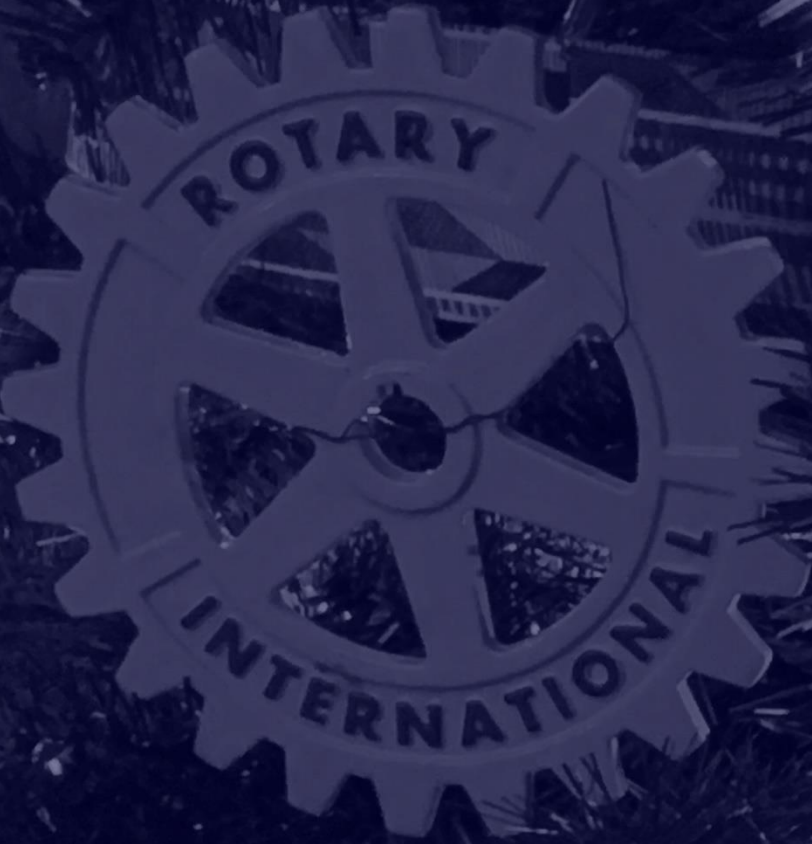

Today's Program: New River Land Trust

The New River Land Trust works to conserve farmland, forests, open spaces, and historic places in the New River region of Southwest Virginia. Since 2002, we have helped protect over 56,000 acres of land in the region and over 26 miles of New River frontage.

Why conserve land? To protect productive farmland, wildlife habitat, scenic views, climate resilient areas, water quality, and outdoor recreation areas in our region. We use cutting-edge technology to identify land in critical need of conservation.

We work with partners, including local governments, on larger land policy and conservation issues, such as the future Brush Mountain Park project. We also educate and assist landowners to conserve their land by voluntarily donating conservation easements on their property.

Rotary Bulletin Sponsorship Opportunities

In an effort to support our local foundation, we offer the chance to sponsor of the weekly bulletin. The sponsor will be highlighted on the 2nd page of each bulletin. Sponsors can be individual Rotarians or your businesses, and may be text or your business logo. If you are interested, please talk to Chris French or Paula Alston. 100% of the sponsorship money will go to our local Foundation to benefit our projects.

- **\$20 for 1 Week Sponsorship**
- **\$50 for 1 Month Sponsorship (Limit 3 Per Sponsor per Rotary Year)**
 - Runs every week for a calendar month
 - Guaranteed to appear in at least 4 bulletins (will flow over to future available weeks in the event less than 4 bulletins are done in that month)
- **\$135 for 3 Month Sponsorship (Limit 1 Per Sponsor per Rotary Year)**
 - Guaranteed to appear in at least 12 bulletins total during current Rotary year
 - Sponsor can decide if weeks should appear consecutively or spread out
- **\$300 for Gold Sponsor (1 Max per Rotary Year)**
 - Runs every week for 3 calendar months
 - Months do not have to be consecutive
 - Runs in additional weeks, as available, until it has been shown at least 20 weeks total during the current Rotary year.
 - After being shown 20 weeks, logo will continue to be shown in any week where no other sponsor is available.
 - **Deadline for rest of 19-20 Rotary Year – 1/8/2021**
 - **Deadline Window for 20-21 Rotary Year – 5/31/2021**
- **\$800 for Platinum Sponsor (1 Available for 2020-2021 Rotary Year)**
 - Runs every week for a Rotary year
 - **Deadline to apply for 20-21 Rotary Year – 3/31/2021**
 - Physical Sign at Meeting (Near Badges) recognizing sponsor at every meeting
