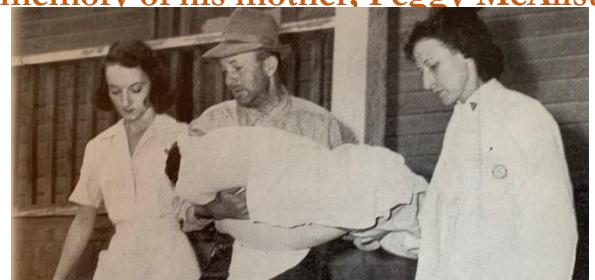
Make your Rotary Foundation donation today!
