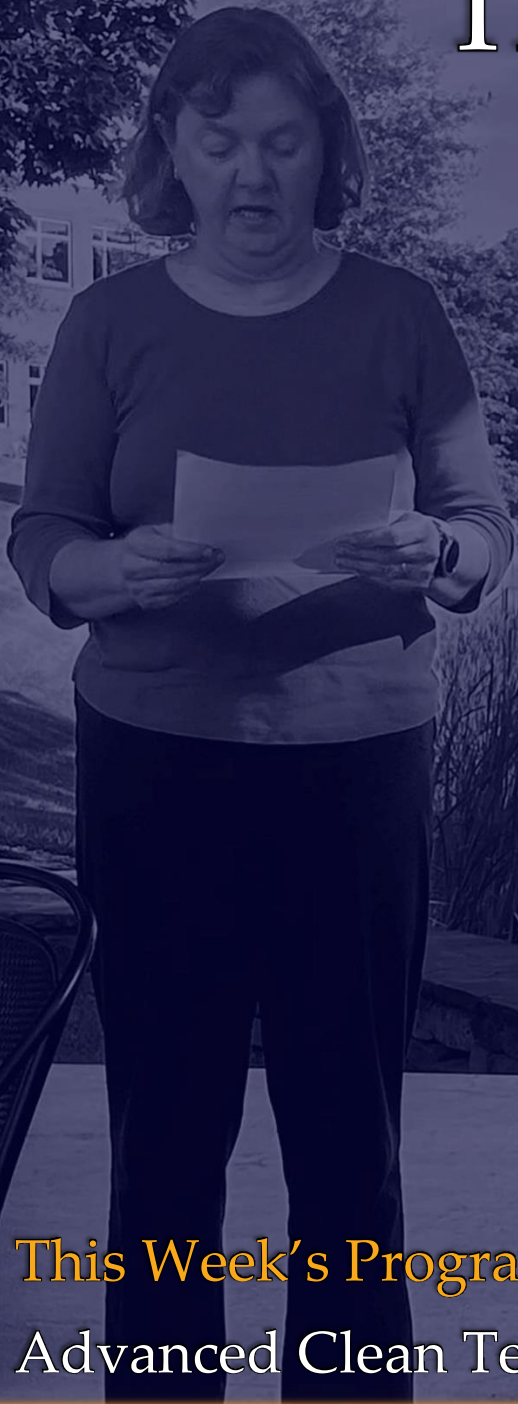

Our partner, the Wheelchair Foundation will arrange for the manufacture of the wheelchairs and have them delivered to a port-of-entry. Local Rotarians will provide the logistics to move the wheelchairs to the locations where they will be distributed.

Tentative plans are to have the wheelchairs distributed in Colombia the second week in December. All Rotarians in the district are invited to travel to Colombia and help in the distribution of the wheelchairs.
