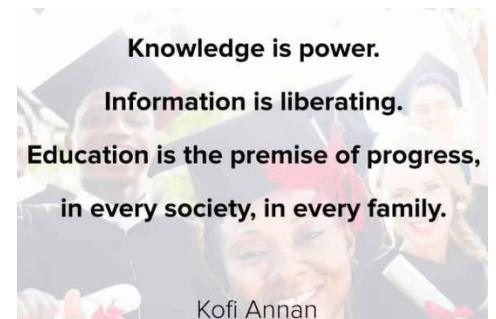
# Rotary Yard Sale
