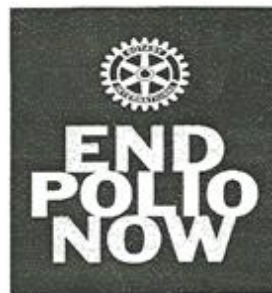
Scott Tison has moved to Northern Virginia and has resigned from the Club.
